### Vespers

Lord I Call (tone 1) (to Seraphim)

Bles-sed is the monastery of Sarov!

It holds thee, O holy father Seraphim, as a treasure of virtues,

A vessel of purity, a guardian of chastity,

A well of grace, a spring of healing!

A physician who took no money from the sick,

A true ascetic who comforted those in affliction,

A <u>peace</u>ful harbor for those tossed in the storms of earthly <u>pas</u>sions!

Therefore we glorify thy memory and entreat thee://1

Pray that the Lord will grant our souls peace and great <u>mer</u>cy!

To<u>day</u> the faithful rejoice in thy memory, O holy father <u>Ser</u>aphim Proclaiming thee with a <u>loud</u> voice.

<u>Theotokion</u> (tone 8)(of the Resurrection)

For our <u>sake Thou</u> wast <u>born</u> of the Virgin and didst endure crucifixion, O <u>Good</u> One, De<u>stroy</u>ing <u>death</u> by <u>death</u> and revealing the resur<u>rec</u>tion as God,

Do not despise the work of Thy hand; reveal Thy love for man, O Merciful One,// And accept the Theotokos praying for us, and save the despairing people, O Savior!

Kontakion (tone 2)(of St Seraphim)

Forsaking the beauty as well as the corruption of this world, O saint,

Thou didst go forth to Sarov where thou didst live as a monk and angel.

Thou didst become the way of salvation for many men,

Therefore Christ hath glorified thee, O father <u>Ser</u>aphim,

Enriching thee with abundant healings and miracles;

Kontakion (tone 4)(of St Macrina)

O ven'rable Macrina,

Thou lovest the good God with <u>all</u> thy heart.

Taking His precious Cross upon thy shoulder,

Thou didst followed after Him with zeal.//
